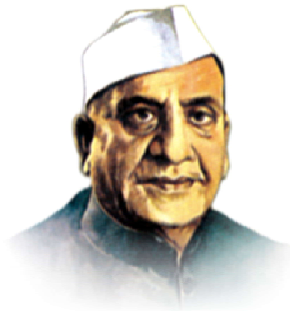

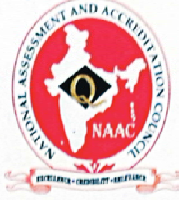

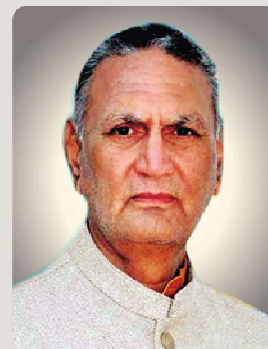

02. Except admissions to UG Part I Classes, eligible students may seek direct admission to Part II and Part III classes.
03. Students should secure admissions as soon as possible, for the number of students in each class is fixed as per govt. rules.
04. Government and University rules are strictly followed regarding admissions, reservations of seats, eligibility criterion, fees structure/s and relevant documents.
05. Admission Form is provided with the prospectus. A candidate must fill up the form in his/her handwriting.
06. Incomplete form, or Form with false or wrong information will be rejected forthwith.
07. Student should attach Original School Leaving Certificate (T. C.) & Mark List along with the admission form.
08. Submission of Eligibility Certificate/ Document to Admission Committee is must for students passing their qualifying examination from other than Maharashtra H. S. S. C. Board.
09. The nature of admission is provisional and is subject to the approval of the university.
10. Students seeking admission to [B. A. Part I], [B. Com. Part I] and [B. Sc. Part I] should submit their original mark lists (attemptwise mark list) and two true copies of each document to obtain university nomination to their admissions.

Fee Concessions

B) Physically Challenged Students (A physically challenged student to not to attend the physical training classes is required to produce a medical certificate from the competent medical authority.) They must also seek the certificate of exemption from Principal by 10th of January every year and attach it with their University Admission Form. Students' Attendance

As per university and government rules & regulations, no student should have his attendance below 75% in classes throughout the academic year. Students below 75% attendance in classes could not claim to appear in university examination.

Anti-Ragging Circular

Action against Ragging: Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act XXXIII of 1999 with effect from May 15th 1999 has following provisions for Action against Ragging.

- a] Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited.
- b] Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term up to TWO YEARS and/or penalty which may extend to ten thousand rupees.
- c] Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of the order of such dismissal.
- d] Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian or a teacher of an educational institution complains in writing of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of the educational institution shall without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated, for further action. Where, on enquiry, by the head of the educational institution, it is found that there is no substance, prima facie, in the complaint received; he/she will intimate the fact, in writing, to the complainant. The decision of the head of the educational institution shall be final.
- e] If the head of the educational institution fails or neglects to act in the manner specified in section “d” above when a complaint of ragging is made, such person shall be deemed to have abetted the offence and shall, on conviction, be punished as provided for in section “b” above.

**Code of conduct (2022-2023)
Code of conduct for Students**

- 1) Students shall come to the college in approved uniforms only.
- 2) Students are expected to maintain the highest standards of discipline inside the College campus.
- 3) All the students are expected to be present in the classes well in time.
- 4) No student shall enter or leave the class room when the session is on without teacher's permission.
- 5) Keep the campus neat and clean. Do not throw waste anywhere in the campus. Use dustbins for this.
- 6) Misbehavior towards girl's students, use of threat or violence against members of the staff or fellow students will be considered as very serious case of misconduct.
- 7) Any act of discrimination (Physical or verbal conduct) based on an individual's gender, caste, religion or religious beliefs, colour, region, language, disability, or sexual orientation, marital or family status, physical or mental disability, gender identity, etc. are seriously punishable.
- 8) Harassing juniors, ill treatment to other fellow students or any such form of ragging is objectionable and liable to be treated as criminal offence by the law enforcing agencies as per the directives of the government of Maharashtra and the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
- 9) All students shall leave the classes immediately after college time. No students shall wander or gather in verandah, corridor, and staircase etc.
- 10) All leave applications (Regular & Medical) shall be submitted in time, for sanction by HOD and concerned teachers. Application for medical leave shall be accompanied by valid medical certificates.
- 11) All the students are expected to remain present for all college functions in the college uniform unless otherwise specified.
- 12) All the students shall wear their identity cards, well displayed. Any teaching staff and non teaching staff shall have the right to peruse it. Denial of that alone will invite disciplinary action.

- 13) All kinds of tattooing, body piercing, hair styling etc. that goes against the existing social norms and which could go against the spirit of society academic values will be referred to the discipline committee.

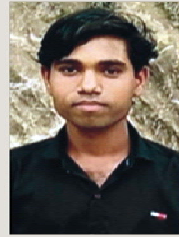
