



Fee Concessions

Medical Check Up

- As stated in the University Ordinance, medical checkup is compulsory for students.
- Students should note that at least 15 days before the commencement of University Examinations (Summer); the Department of Physical Education displays the dates for medical checkup.

Physical Efficiency Test

- All the students must attend physical training sessions held in morning/evening on college campus. The physical efficiency test that takes place at least 15 days before the commencement of University Examinations (both Semesters). For Part I & Part II undergraduate students 75% attendance is necessary to attend the test. Absentee in the physical efficiency test shall cost a fine of Rs. 10/-
- The following students are exempted from the regular physical training classes/sessions. However, they are not exempted from the physical efficiency test.
 - A) Students having attained the age of 26 years.
 - B) Physically Challenged Students (A physically challenged student to not to attend the physical training classes is required to produce a medical certificate from the competent medical authority.) They must also seek the certificate of exemption from Principal by $10^{\rm th}$ of January every year and attach it with their University Admission Form. Students' Attendance

As per university and government rules & regulations, no student should have his attendance below 75% in classes throughout the academic year. Students below 75% attendance in classes could not claim to appear in university examination.

Important Note:-

- College is opening on 3rd July, 2023. Part I & Part II UG students whose results are not declared, but are due to confirm their admissions in Part II & Part III are hereby informed to attend the classes from 15th July, 2023.
- Bills, Advertisements, or Notices of any kind cannot be displayed on college premises without prior permission of the Principal.
- Chewing tobacco, chewing pan, smoking are strictly prohibited on college premises. Anyone found doing so shall be liable for disciplinary action against him.
- Student who cancels his/her admission for any reason will have to pay full fees and other
 related fees for the whole session. The student will not be returned his/her original
 documents he/she had attached with the admission form at the time of his/her cancellation
 of the admission.
- Students missing the classes will be fined Rs.05/- per period. If they remain absent for a week, Principal will take a stern action against them.

Anti-Mobile Usage Act

Mobile Phone used by students is strictly prohibited on college campus as per 'Anti-Mobile Phone Act'. Students found using Mobile Phone on the campus will be imposed with Rs. 1000/- as an amount of fine.

Anti-Ragging Circular

Action against Ragging: Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act XXXIII of 1999 with effect from May 15th 1999 has following provisions for Action against Ragging.

- a] Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited.
- b] Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term up to TWO YEARS and/or penalty which may extend to ten thousand rupees.
- c] Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of the order of such dismissal.
- d] Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian or a teacher of an educational institution complains in writing of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of the educational institution shall without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated, for further action. Where, on enquiry, by the head of the educational institution, it is found that there is no substance, prima facie, in the complaint received; he/she will intimate the fact, in writing, to the complainant. The decision of the head of the educational institution shall be final.
- e] If the head of the educational institution fails or neglects to act in the manner specified in section "d" above when a complaint of ragging is made, such person shall be deemed to have abetted the offence and shall, on conviction, be punished as provided for in section "b" above.

Code of conduct (2023-2024) Code of conduct for students

- 1) Students shall come to the college in approved uniforms only.
- 2) Students are expected to maintain the highest standards of discipline inside the College campus.
- 3) All the students are expected to be present in the classes well in time.
- 4) No student shall enter or leave the class room when the session is on without teacher's permission.
- 5) Keep the campus neat and clean. Do not throw waste anywhere in the campus. Use dustbins for this.
- 6) Misbehavior towards girl's students, use of threat or violence against members of the staff or fellow students will be considered as very serious case of misconduct.
- 7) Any act of discrimination (Physical or verbal conduct) based on an individual's gender, caste, religion or religious beliefs, colour, region, language, disability, or sexual orientation, marital or family
- status, physical or mental disability, gender identity, etc. are seriously punishable.
- 8) Harassing juniors, ill treatment to other fellow students or any such form of ragging is objectionable and liable to be treated as criminal offence by the law enforcing agencies as per the directives of the government of Maharashtra and the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
- 9) All students shall leave the classes immediately after college time. No students shall wander or gather in verandah, corridor, and staircase etc.
- 10) All leave applications (Regular & Medical) shall be submitted in time, for sanction by HOD and concerned teachers. Application for medical leave shall be accompanied by valid medical certificates.
- 11) All the students are expected to remain present for all college functions in the college uniform unless otherwise specified.
