Department of National Service Scheme (NSS)

Introduction :-

The overall aim of NSS as envisaged earlier, is to give an extension dimension to the higher education system and orient the student youth to community service while they are studying in educational institution. The educated youth who are expected to take the reins of administration in future are found to be unaware of the problems of the village/slum community and in certain cases are indifferent towards their needs and problems. Therefore it is necessary to arouse the social conscience of the students, and to provide them an opportunity to work with the people in the villages and slums. It is felt that **their interaction with the common villages and slum dwellers will expose them to the realities of life and bring about a change in their social perception.**

The N.S.S. Symbol is embossed on N.S.S. Badge. The N.S.S. volunteers wear it while undertaking various community programmes of community service. There are 24 wheels in 'Rath' of Sun Temple of Konark. Each wheel has eight bars, which represents 8 Prahars of day. Hence the badge reminds the wearer to be in readiness for service of the nation round the clock i.e. for 24 hours or 8 Prahars. The red colour in the badge indicates that the NSS volunteers are full of block, i.e. lively, active and spirited. The navy blue colour indicates the cosmos of which the NSS is a tiny part ready to contribute its share for the welfare of the mankind.

Mission & Vision:-

- Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem solving process.
- Develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility.
- Utilize their knowledge in finding practical solution to individual and community problems.

- Develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters.
- Practice national integration and social harmony.

Function :-

- i) **Nature of N.S.S.** :- Social service scheme for students sponsored by Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India for the under-graduate students.
- ii) **Birth of N.S.S.:-** September, 1969 during Gandhi centenary year and during 4th Five year plan 1969-74.
- iii) **Year of Establishment in college : - 1971**

iv) **Moto of N.S.S. :- Not me, But you.**

v) **Goal of N.S.S. :-** Education through community service and community service through education.

vi) **Obligation of N.S.S. Volunteers :-** To work for two continued years along with their studies, putting in 120 hours service each year and participating in one Special Camping Program.

vii) **Pride of N.S.S. Volunteers :-** N.S.S. Badge and N.S.S. certificate which will stand volunteers in good stand in future career. 5 additional marks will be given for the 120 hours of N.S.S. Activity and 1 marks for Special Camp.

viii) **Principal Elements in N.S.S. :-** There are four principal elements in the N.S.S. Program me Process. The students, the teachers the community and the programme.

viii) **Programme of N.S.S. :-** Two fold programme : Regular activities and Special Camping.

ix) N.S.S. Programme is flexible with no rigidity. Any useful programme in the light of the need of the community & the occasion can be taken up in consultation with the university.

x) **Special camping :-** Camping is an important activity of N.S.S. special camps are held at the college level for 7 days duration winter breaks in rural areas. The normal strength of a camp is 50% of total sanctioned strength.

Campers enjoy the camp life, learn the virtues of good citizenship and render service to the community.
