Excursion Report

Department of Botany was organised Botanical excursion for B. Sc I, II III year & M. Sc I & II yr students at Shekdari forest & Lake on Thursday dated 25/09/2025. Our Principal Dr. D. V. Hande sir & Head Department of Botany Dr. S. V. Satpute was very kind enough to permit this tour.

Journey to Shekdari forest started from our college campus at 9.00 am. Total 27 students and 3 teaching staff members & 1 non-teaching staff were participated in the tour. On the way to Shekdari we observed natural beauty in forest as “flame of forest” *Butea monosperma*, *Bombax ceiba*, *Melia azadiracta*, *Azadirachta indica*, *Hyptis*, *Wrightia tinctoria*, *Tephrosia*, *Tectona grandis*, *Lantana camara*, & plants of families included in our syllabus. We also observed some Algal flora in Shekdari lake & some bryophytes in marshy places.

We reached at Shekdari forest at around 10.00 am. There was visited various picnic points like Shekdari garden, Tiger point, medicinal plants. We observed and collected medicinal viz. *Wrightia tinctoria*, *Indigofera*, *Opunsia*, *Mytinus emarginata*, *Dicstoma*, & some fungal forms from these point. We were very fortunate to observed different species of Angiosperm, and Gymnosperms growing in garden at Shekdari. The forest is a dry deciduous type of forest and support rich diversity of lower and the flowering plants. This Shekdari forest is well known for wildlife.

Dr. M.B.Bobade sir, Dr. P. J. Deshmukh madam, Prof. S. S . Sakhre (Incharge of tour) guided to students during excursion and made familiar with different plants and their economic importance of plants. On the return journey we visited temple and observed different ornamental plants. At 3.00 pm we left Shekdari and reached at Warud around 4.00 pm.

Plants of families observed during excursion: *Euphorbiaceae*, *Malvaceae*, *Asteraceae*, *Bignoniaceae*, *Lamiaceae*, *Meliaceae*, and *Apiaceae*

Gymnosperm plants: *Cycas*, *Thusa*, *Araucaria*
