The event was aimed at creating awareness among students regarding the enormous diversity, ecological importance, and industrial applications of fungi. It served as a platform to highlight the vital role of fungi in maintaining ecological balance, their contribution to decomposition, nutrient recycling, and their vast potential in pharmaceutical, agricultural, and biotechnological industries.

The primary objectives behind organizing these events were:

- To educate and inspire students about the immense diversity and functional roles of fungi in nature and industry.
- To enhance scientific curiosity and research aptitude among life science students towards mycology and its applications.
- To develop a spirit of creativity, observation, and entrepreneurship among the students through participatory activities.

- To encourage interdisciplinary learning connecting mycology with environmental conservation, agriculture, and industry.

Participation

A total of **62 students** registered and actively participated in the competitions organized under this event, which included *Poster Presentation, Model Making, and Photography Competitions*.

The inclusion of students from these neighbouring institutions enriched the intercollegiate dimension of the event, fostering collaborative learning and creative exchange.

Participants represented diverse academic backgrounds, primarily from the life sciences, biotechnology, microbiology, and agricultural sciences. They showcased their innovative ideas through artistic and scientific expressions focusing on fungal biodiversity, ecological significance, and industrial utility of fungi. The registration process was carried out in both online and offline modes, ensuring maximum accessibility to students from varied regions and disciplines.

EVENT DESCRIPTION:

The “**World Fungus Day**” program was organized with great enthusiasm on **1st October 2025** at **Mahatma Fule Arts, Commerce and Sitaramji Chaudhari Science College, Warud, Dist. Amravati**, in **collaboration with the Mycological Society of India (MSI) and its Amravati Unit**. The celebration commenced with the **ribbon-cutting ceremony** performed by the **Hon’ble Principal, Dr. D. V. Hande**, marking the formal inauguration of the event. This was followed by a warm **welcome and floral felicitation** of all the distinguished guests and dignitaries present on the dais, including members of the jury panel, coordinators, and invited guests, by the faculty members and students of the Department of Botany.

The event was gracefully **anchored by Dr. P. J. Deshmukh**, who kept the audience engaged with her dynamic presentation and smooth coordination throughout the session. The program began with an **introductory address by Dr. S. V. Satpute**, Head of the Department of Botany, who delivered an insightful talk highlighting the ecological role of fungi in nutrient cycling, organic matter decomposition, and maintaining environmental balance. He emphasized that fungi are nature’s finest recyclers, contributing to soil fertility and the sustainability of ecosystems.

Following this, **Prof. L. K. V. Pawar** delivered a thoughtful speech appreciating the initiative taken by the department to promote fungal education among students. He underlined the importance of recognizing fungi as a crucial component of biodiversity with immense biotechnological and industrial potential.

Bobade** for Model Making, and **Dr. M. B. Bobade** for Photography.

Bakale**, who meticulously assessed each entry based on creativity, scientific understanding, and presentation skills. In the Poster Presentation Competition, the First Prize was awarded to **Miss Vaishali Kharpuriya** from Arvind Babu Deshmukh College, Bharshingi; the Second Prize went to **Mr. Devendra Almast** from the Mahatma Fule Mahavidyalaya Warud; the Third Prize was secured by Samiksha Wankhade from Bhartiya Mahavidyalaya Amravati; and the Consolation Prize was given to **Miss Mohini Karolkar** from Arvind Babu Deshmukh College, Bharshingi.

In the Model Making Competition, the First Prize was awarded to **Miss Grishma Daware** (Mahatma Fule Mahavidyalaya, Warud), the Second Prize went to **Miss Vaishnavi Satnurkar** (Mahatma Fule Mahavidyalaya, Warud), the Third Prize was won by **Miss Shrutika Mamarde** (Bhartiya Mahavidyalaya, Amravati), and the Consolation Prize went to **Miss Monishka p. Mandre** (Mahatma Fule Mahavidyalaya Warud).

In the Photography Competition, the First Prize was again secured by **Miss Kundan Nandane** (Bhartiya Mahavidyalaya Amravati), followed by **Miss Prachi Lohkarar** (Bhartiya Mahavidyalaya, Amravati) as Second Prize Winner, **Miss Chaitali Mendhe** (Mahatma Fule Mahavidyalaya, Warud) as Third Prize Winner, and **Miss Neha Buwade** (Mahatma Fule Mahavidyalaya, Warud) receiving the Consolation Prize.

The **presidential address** was delivered by **Dr. D. V. Hande**, Principal of the college, who shared a comprehensive and inspiring speech on the applications of mushrooms and fungi in various fields such as medicine, agriculture, food industry, and environmental biotechnology.
