Report

Department of Botany organized 'Regional Workshop on Ethnobotany' on 13th and 14th December, 2019. Workshop was organized to discuss various issues related with 'Ethnobotany', such as herbal treatments, availability of herbs, status of medicinal plants in the wild, conservation of medicinal plants, cultivation of medicinal plants, wild vegetables and issues related with local herbal healers.

To address these issues we had invited guests from Pune (MH) and Chitrakut (MP). On 13th Dec., 2019. Local herbal healers (10) of Warud area and peoples from Warud who are interested in this field were also invited as guest.

Winner: Ankush Nimbalkar, Shri Pundlik Maharaj Mahavidyalaya, Nandura, Dist. Buldhana



Study of 'Wild Vegetables'




